Custaloga Town Scout Reservation **Description of Facilities Available-as of September 2008**

ADIRONDACKS—Sleeps 16 people total. Consists of 4 cabins each sleeping 4 people; each has a fireplace. No electricity. Water and latrine nearby.

ADMINISTRATION BUILDING (meeting side only)—Sleeps 22 people. Army style bunks stacked 2 high. Wood-burning heat stove along with electric cook stove. Tables and benches to accommodate 24 people. Furnished with electric lights. Water and latrine nearby.

CUB PAVILION/CABIN—Sleeps 12 people. Army style bunks stacked 2 high. Wood-burning heat stove and electricity. Water and latrine nearby.

WILSON DINING HALL—Sleeps 50 people. Canvas folding cots and electricity. Water and latrine nearby, Gas heaters are available. Separate fees for kitchen (see application)

GRANDIN NATURE LODGE—Sleeps 24 people. Army style bunks stacked 2 high. Wood-burning heat stove, benches and table. Electricity. Water and latrine nearby.

HANDICRAFT LODGE (Director's Side)—Sleeps 13 people. Wooden built in bunks stacked 3 high. Wood-burning heat stove, tables, benches and electric lights. Must carry water. Latrine nearby.

HANDICRAFT LODGE (Craft Side)—Sleeps 30 people. Army style metal bunks stacked 2 high. Wood-burning heat stove. Electric lights. Must carry water. Latrine nearby.

McCARL COTTAGE-Back Section (Female Use Only)—Sleeps 8 people. Heated running water, flush toilets, Shower Kitchen with Gas range.

McCARL COTTAGE-Front Section (Female Use Only)—Sleeps 11 people. Heated running water, flush toilets.

MOSS TRAINING CENTER—Sleeps 28 people on Army style bunks stacked 2 high. Central forced air heat. Hot and cold running water, flush toilets, showers, kitchen with electric range. Unit must set up and take down cots.

BRENNER PAVILLION - Picnic tables. Water and latrine nearby.

SETON PAVILLION - Picnic tables. Water and latrine nearby.

JAMESTOWN LIONS PAVILLION - Picnic tables. Water and latrine in nearby campsites.

RIFLE RANGE PAVILLION - Picnic tables. Water and latrine nearby

ARCHERY PAVILLION - Picnic tables. Water and latrine nearby

CAMPSITES - These do not have any facilities for unit use. Each unit must furnish their own tents and other materials. Latrine and water located at central locations. Campsites are: Beard, Boyce, Lower Drake, Upper Drake, Perry, Powell, Schell Seton, Shenango and West.

Rowboats and canoes may be rented for use on the lake or river near CTSR. The fee is 12 per day per boat. Units must provide current BSA Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat certified supervision or equivalent. Prior reservations are required. (See application).

- Accidents that happen at camp <u>must</u> be reported to Campmaster or Ranger immediately. Accident report must be filed by leader in charge and sent to FCC Service Center ASAP.
- Anyone using ANY camp facilities at the camp must make reservations two weeks in advance through the French Creek Council Service Center.
- ALL reservations must be paid at the French Creek Council Service Center two weeks in advance of the weekend.
- Canceling reservations must be done 2 weeks prior to the event in order to receive a refund.
- Units must check in and out with the Campmaster or Ranger.
- The Campmaster for the weekend has complete charge of the camp and all groups using it.
- Units must have two adult leaders in camp at ALL times. At least one must be over 21 years of age.
- Male and female leaders are required to have separate sleeping facilities. (See McCarl Cottage)
- Cub Scouts may only camp at council-owned properties.
- All Cub Scout camping is to be done on a parent/Cub basis.
- All units should plan to check out of camp before 1:00 PM on Sunday, unless other arrangements have been made in advance.
- NO alcohol, drugs or firecrackers will be permitted in camp at ANY time.
- Powersaws and related equipment must be used by responsible adults only.
- NO recreational vehicles are permitted in camp (Snowmobiles, ATV's, Dirt Bikes etc.) If in question, check with the Ranger or Campmaster.
- Adequate supply of firewood must be left when checking out of any camp facility. Units will be held responsible for any damge done to any camp facility.
- NO pets are permitted in camp.
- ALL garbage must be taken to the dumpster located at the maintenance building (near the Ranger's house)
- NO hunting is permitted on camp property
- Before having any activities on or near the lake, check with the Ranger or Campmaster FIRST.
- Sledding is not permitted.
- Ice skating is permitted upon approval by Ranger..
- Violation of ANY of the above policies could result in suspension of the privilege of using facilities at Custaloga Town.
- The Scout Oath and Law will be the guiding principles for all that use these camp facilities.

Areas off limits:

- 1. The Ranger's home and grounds.
- 2. Water towers, pumping stations, filtration houses.
- 3. Climbing Tower
