Description of Facilities at Custaloga Town Scout Reservation

Rental September through May is from Friday 6:00PM to Sunday 1:00PM.

The use of portable stoves (gas, charcoal, or any open flame) are not permitted inside any building

Adirondacks: These are open front lean-to facilities with a bank fireplace. There are 4 structures, each capable of sleeping 4 persons. Water & Latrine near-by. No electric. Metal beds, no mattresses.

Administration Building: Trading Post area only, bunk beds with mattresses, Table and benches, Wood-burning heat stove. Electric lights. Water and Latrine near-by.

Cub Pavilion: Cabin space for sleeping with attached pavilion for activities, bunk beds, no mattresses, picnic tables, Wood burning heat stove, Electric lights. Water and Latrine near-by.

Nature Lodge: Bunk beds with mattresses, table and benches, Wood-burning heat stove, Electric Lighting, Water and Latrine near-by. Porch overlooking Beaver Pond.

Handicraft Lodge: Separate sleeping facilities to accommodate co-ed group. Bunk beds with mattresses, table and benches, Wood-burning heat stove, Electric lights, Water and Latrine near-by.

McCarl Cottage: Also known as First Aid/Cooks Cabin. Gas Heat, Flush Toilets, Hot Showers, Bunk Beds with mattresses, & separate sleeping facilities to accommodate co-ed groups, Cook Stove, Table & Chairs.

Note: If facility is not reserved, it may be rented to accommodate female leaders at \$10 fee per person.

Moss Training Center: Gas Heat, Flush Toilets, Hot Showers, Bunk Beds with mattresses, Army cots, Large Kitchen, and Cafeteria Tables.

Sci-Tech: Gas Heat, Bunk Beds, co-ed division (4 bunk beds, with mattresses in smaller room) and also conference style room with cots if needed. Water and Latrine near-by.

Campsites/Pavilions: Primitive camping, units must bring all equipment, tents, etc. Tent platforms and picnic tables may be available at the ranger's discretion. No nailing of tarps to pavilions is permitted.

Custaloga Town Scout Reservation and the French Creek Council.

Canoes and Trailer: PA Licensed canoes and trailer are available for rental per day or for the weekend.

Proper training certification is required.

Rifle/shotgun range: The rifle/shotgun range facility is available for rental by Scouting and non-scouting groups. A qualified/certified approved range officer must be present. Only CTSR firearms/ammunition permitted.

Archery Range: The archery facility is available for rental for Scouting and non-scouting programs. A qualified/certified approved range officer must be present. Only CTSR bows and arrows permitted.

Climbing Tower/Zip Line: The climbing/rappelling tower and Zip Line are available for use by Scouting and non-scouting groups. A qualified/certified approved climbing instructor must be present. Only CTSR Equipment permitted. Not available November thru March.

Dining Hall/Kitchen: (Restricted) Sleeping (50 cots) is permitted in the Dining Hall with prior approval. Kitchen use is by permission only and may require a deposit and/or certification.
