## FEBRUARY 2, 2013 CUSTALOGA TOWN SCOUT RESERVATION

### General Information:

- Lunch is to be a hot meal carried on your sled for the morning.
- There will be separate awards for Webelos dens.
- Boy Scout leaders are not permitted to help their patrols in any way. Should this occur, the patrol will be disqualified from the particular event. Webelos leaders will be permitted to accompany the den and provide minimal assistance.
- All Sleds must be Klondike type, and wheels are not permitted.
- Absolutely no carrying of your sled.
- The official BSA Medical Form is required for the event. The forms will be turned in at registration
- Staff decisions are final.
- All stations must be completed in order; if you arrive out of turn or early, you will be directed to the correct station.
- Klondike staff will not provide scoring information to the patrols.
- Patrols will have 30 minutes to complete each station, with 5 minutes of travel time between them.
- Bring your team spirit and teamwork

### Specific Station Information:

BASIC FIRE BUILDING -- No chemical fire starters (including lighters), wood and kindling will NOT be provided.

HILL CLIMB -- Only the materials provided at the station location will be permitted for scoring

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### Sled Requirements:

Be prepared! All items **must** be on your sled the **entire day!**

No one will be allowed to return to their vehicle for lunch unless there is a medical or safety reason to obtain dry clothes.

Keep this form with your Patrol Entry Form and be ready to produce it for sled judging.

- Traditional Sled with ground cloth or tarp
- Clipboard with pencil
- Compass
- Patrol roster: Patrol name, Troop/Pack, District, Scout names with addresses and phone numbers
- First aid kit including \$0.50 for emergency phone call
- Stretcher or 2 stretcher poles
- 3 blankets
- Materials to make splints and slings
- Fire building materials including fire starter (flint & steel, bow and drill, hot spark)
- Two 25' ropes 3/8" diameter or larger
- One 50' rope 3/8" diameter or larger
- Six (minimum) 6' ropes 1/4" diameter
- 2 garbage bags
- 2 gallons of water (enough drinking water/scout plus for cooking their lunch)
- Personal water bottle required for each member of patrol
- Enough food and mess kits to prepare a HOT lunch for your entire patrol
- One change of dry socks for all members of your patrol
- A small patrol and American Flag
- Scout Handbooks – you must have at least one
- Signaling device
- Sunscreen – use it if it is sunny; you can get sunburned even in the winter
- Scout knife AND Totin' Chip card on person (at least one member of the patrol)
- EACH member wearing appropriate gloves, head, and footgear
- Saw in an appropriate safety case
- Hand ax or hatchet with appropriate cover
