General Information:

- **MAXIMUM OF 8 SCOUTS PER SLED ENFORCED FOR SAFETY OF SCOUTS**
- Only Scouts, BSA, Venture Crews, Webelos/AOL Scouts. No Cub Scouts or Siblings.
- Two deep leadership is needed to travel with each sled.
- Each sled team will need a Patrol name, roster and Part A/B medical forms for each member at check-in.
- The first place winner will receive the Traveling Trophy and host next year's Derby.
- All sleds must be Klondike type sleds. No wheels are permitted. All sleds must be equipped with any tools and supplies needed for the events.
- Stations will be First Aid, Fire Building, Hill Climb, Knots/Lashings, Map & Compass, Blind Obstacle Course, Balance Board and Shelter Building. Scout Trivia will be included at each station.

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Required Equipment for Klondike Sled

- At least 1 ground cloth or tarp
- Clipboard with pencil
- Compass
- Scout roster including address & phone numbers, Patrol name, Unit Number, District
- First Aid Kit
- Materials to make splints and slings
- Signaling Device
- Stretches or 2 stretcher poles
- 3 blankets
- Scout Knife and Totin' Chip Card
- Saw in an appropriate case
- Hand Ax with Safety Cover
- Fire Starting and Fire Building Materials. Firem'n Chit Card.
- 3 - 25 ft. or longer ropes, 3/8 in. diameter or larger
- 1 - 50 ft. or longer rope, 3/8 in diameter or larger
- Paracord or Twine
- 2 Garbage bags
- 2 Gallons of Water (enough for drinking and cooking)
- Personal water bottles required for each member of patrol
- Enough food to prepare as hot lunch for entire patrol
- Equipment to cook hot meal and mess kits for patrol
- An American and Patrol flag for sled
- Scout Handbook
- Extra appropriate weather gear (hats, socks & gloves) for all patrol members
